## LWV HEALTH CARE POSITION

Check the LWVUS website for more information. The complete position is found in the publication IMPACT ON ISSUES a Guide to Public Policy Positions, available on this website.

The LWV-US believes that a basic level of quality care at affordable cost should be available to all U.S. residents. Other U.S. health care policy goals should include the equitable distribution of services, efficient and economical delivery of care, advancement of medical research and technology, and a reasonable total national expenditure level for health care.

The League is opposed to a strictly private market-based model of financing the health care system. The League is also opposed to the administration of the health care system solely by the private sector or the states.

Cost Control methods should include reduction of administrative costs, regional planning, establishment of maximum levels of public reimbursement to providers, malpractice reform, use of managed care, utilization review of treatment, mandatory second opinions before surgery or extensive treatment, consumer accountability through deductibles and co-payments.
